There are some additional costs that you may wish to consider when planning to deliver Peer2Peer. To what extent you provide any of the things listed is entirely up to yourself and dependant on your own organisations circumstances.

Costs you may want to build into you budget could include;

Notes

- Planning time – time that may need to be accounted/paid for?
- Resource development – printing, workshop materials, IT equipment
- Pay and expenses of facilitators
- Expenses – refreshments, travel, childcare, additional support
- Venue – do you need to pay for a venue?
- Is there any additional IT required?
- Celebration event – costs if hosting an event with catering for guests
